Forklift Grapples - Grapples work together with the crowning operation of the bucket cylinder located on the excavator. They can mount directly onto the jib or whichever quick hitch which is in bucket position. Grapples are normally meant for the handling and processing of construction materials, timber, domestic and aggregate waste items. The grapple's boxed design has additional support bridging. This manufactured design provides the grapple with maximum support and strength by means of preventing the body from breaking and turning all through its operation.
